

2018 SCHOOL AUCTION

ART SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

General Guidelines:

1. Kindergarten through 11th grade is eligible to participate in the Art Show at the Auction (*April 6, 2018*).
2. A local artist will come to judge. There will be 4 categories: Kinder – 1st, 2-3, 4-6, 7-11th.
3. Artwork must be started during the 2017-2018 school year and not done previously. Completed artwork will need to be turned in *on or before March 23, 2018, to Mrs. Portillo (Art & Spanish teacher)*.
4. Only the student may work on his or her own artwork. If the artwork is done by another student, parent, friend, etc., their artwork will be disqualified.
5. All artwork must be *titled, framed, and ready to display* in the Art Show at the Auction when turned in.
6. Artwork must be complete and dry when turned in. The artwork must not be so fragile that it falls apart, as the artwork will be moved around many times as the auction is set up.
7. Minimum size of all artwork (including photographs) is 8"x10" and maximum size is 18"x24".
8. Each student must fill out the necessary paperwork and turned in with artwork on or before: *March 23, 2018 to Mrs. Portillo*.
9. Artwork must follow the school rules and Christian moral values. Any subject matter that is highly controversial or may detract from the general character of the Auction & Art Show (guns, violence, etc.) will not be allowed.
10. Types of artwork that will *not* be permitted:
 - a. Pre-Packaged Art Kits
 - b. Paint By Number
 - c. Color By Number
 - d. Stencils
 - e. Rub on Letters
 - f. Traced Artwork.

Judging:

1. Originality: Is the concept or idea original? Is it the student's own work?
2. Creativity: Does the piece of art show the student's imagination? Is the subject matter unique? Is the interpretation innovative?
3. Skill: Skill is assessed based on the age of the artist.
4. Excellence in drawing: What extent of accuracy has the student achieved? How difficult is the media? Evaluate the student's use of color, drawing, hues, shading, and textures.

Awards:

1. Each category will have a 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place Winner: Kindergarten – 1st Grades, 2nd – 3rd Grades, 4th – 6th Grades, & 7th – 11th Grades. Winners will be awarded at the end of the Talent Show, as well as all participants will be given a certificate. So be sure to attend to receive your award.

Auction:

1. All artwork entered in the Art Show at the Auction will be a part of the Silent Auction, with direct proceeds benefiting AFBCS. The bidder with the highest bid will take home the art the night of the auction. Be sure to attend the auction so that you and your family can bid on your artwork.
