BLUE STAR GRADING SYSTEM, MEDAL QUALIFICATIONS & ASSESSMENT

RECITATION:

- The recitation of the monthly Blue Star is mandatory for all students kindergarten through 12th grade, and it will be counted as a **test grade**. As a student is reciting their Blue Star scripture, teachers will take off *two points per help* given by the teacher or mistake made by the student.
 - o <u>For Example:</u> If the teacher gives the student 5 helps, the student can still receive a 90.
 - In total, the student could receive 15 helps and/or make 15 mistakes (15 total) and earn a passing grade (70) for his/her test grade and would still qualify to earn the Blue Star Medal.
 - o If the student receives 20 helps, the student would earn a 60 for his/her test grade, and so on.
 - If it is recited on or before the due date and if the student makes a 70 or above, it is a Blue Star.

RED STAR:

- Red Stars can be given if the student recites scripture after the due date.
- If the student does not recite it by the deadline and he/she recites it one day late, the beginning grade would be an 80 with no helps or mistakes for a *secondary student*. The beginning grade would be a 90 with no helps or mistakes for an *elementary student*.
- After one day late, the student would receive a zero, per our late policy.
